Unique Warm Weather Animals

What is a rainforest and what animals live there? Learn about the rainforest layers and how animals, snakes, insects and birds have adapted to living in a very warm, very dark and very wet environment. We'll take a nature walk to find leaves for own classroom rainforest.

Creepy Crawly Creatures

Some crawl, some fly, some wiggle, some walk on tall legs. Spiders, caterpillars, insects, and worms are fun to watch, interesting to learn about and still kind of creepy. Using recycled items we will make creepy crawly creatures of our own.

Sharks! And Other Great Ocean Swimmers

Learn about the different varieties of shark that live in the oceans. Talk about giant sea turtles, the largest whales in the ocean, squid with super long tentacles, creatures with giant, sharp teeth and swimmers that glow in the dark. We'll make ocean wave bottles to take home.

Amazing Cold Weather Animals

Animals such as seal, polar bear, narwhal, orca, and penguin call the North and South Pole areas their home. We will learn about where they live, what they eat and other fun facts. Icy animal and water tubs and cold ice pops add to our "chilly" week.

What Happened to the Dinosaurs?

Dinosaurs disappeared millions of years ago and will never return. We will talk about reasons for them disappearing, and how this could happen to animals living on earth today. Children will come up with a plan to help animals survive by deciding what they can do to help endangered species to repopulate and thrive.
